Introduction

Discussion

- I. Ecclesiastes 3:1-8
 - A. We must realize that there are different times that different things are needed.
 - B. Although short, these truths are powerful.
 - C. Cross references (Rom. 13:1-6; Psm. 119;104; Jer. 20:9).
- II. Psalm 46:10
 - A. We need to be reminded that God is still in control, regardless of the situation.
 - B. Although short, this verse helps us to find peace.
 - C. Cross references (Rom. 11:22; Phil. 4:8; 1 Tim. 4:15).
- III. John 8:32
 - A. Mankind should have a great admiration for God's Word.
 - B. Although short, this verse shows the power of the Scriptures (2 Tim. 3:16-17).
 - C. Cross references (Rom. 6:12-23; Psm. 19:7-10; 119:105; Prov. 6:23; 3:5-6; 1 Thess. 5:21).

Conclusion

- I. Passages in the Bible do not have to be long to be powerful.
- II. Sometimes the simplest things can make a big difference.
