- VI. Prejudice (Matt. 13:15; Acts 7:51-53; Jer. 6:16).
- VII. Unwillingness to change (Isa. 55:7; Acts 3:19).
- VIII. Want to be in the majority (Luke 14:26; Matt. 10:35-38).
- IX. Do not believe in Hell (Rev. 20:15; 21:8; Matt. 25:46).
