Introduction

- I. How can we be so sure that Jesus is the Son of God?
- II. There is sufficient evidence to sustain our faith (Heb. 11:1).

Discussion

- I. There are trustworthy sources that acknowledge that Jesus is the Son of God.
 - A. Angels (Luke 1:32; 2:8-20).
 - B. The Father (Matt. 3:13-17; 17:1-5; 2 Pet. 1:16-19).
 - C. The Holy Spirit (John 1:32-34).
 - D. Others (Acts 1:1-3, 9-11; John 6:62; Luke 24:50-52;
- II. People felt “small” in the presence of Jesus (Matt 3:11-12; 27:54; Mark 15:39; Luke 5:1-9; Luke 23:47).
- III. Jesus fulfilled all prophecies about the Christ.
 - A. Of the seed of woman (Gen. 3:15; Isa. 7:14; Gal. 4:4).
 - B. He was of the lineage of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, Judah, and David (Gal. 3:8, 16; Rom. 9:10-11; Heb. 7:11-14; Rom. 1:4; Matt. 1:1-2).
 - C. Was to be crucified (Isa. 53; Mark 8:31; 1 Cor. 15:3).
 - D. Was to be resurrected on the third day (Isa. 53:10; Acts 2:29-36; 1 Cor. 15:1-8).
 - E. There are many other prophecies.
