

# **“We Believe in God”**

## **Heb. 11:6**

### Introduction

- I. Man cannot not be fickle about faith in God (Heb. 11:6).
- II. We must be willing to defend our faith at any time (1 Pet. 3:15).
- III. Faith gives us the ability to “overcome” (1 John 5:4).
- IV. Atheism gives nothing but hopelessness (Psm. 14:1).

### Discussion

- I. One would have to possess absolute knowledge, therefore being God Himself, to know that there is no God (Psm. 14:1).
- II. For every effect there must be an adequate cause.
  - A. Man did not create himself, or the universe.
  - B. The universe did not create itself.
  - C. Therefore the law of cause and effect (Gen. 2:7; 1:1).
  - D. There is a “builder” (Heb. 3:4; cf. Gen. 1:1, 26-27; 2:7; Acts 17:26).
  - E. Just think of the intricacy of the human body-demands a Creator.
- III. God is everlasting (Psm. 90:1-3).
  - A. He is the same God now that He always has been or will ever be (Rom. 16:26).
  - B. Psm. 19:1
- IV. We must never forget the law of biogenesis.
  - A. Life comes from life.
  - B. We serve the living God (Jer. 10:10).
- V. We must remember that we walk by faith and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7; cf. Heb. 11:1).

### Conclusion

- I. It is reasonable, logical, and intelligent to believe in God.
- II. Let us never allow error to sway us from this truth.
