Introduction

- I. How serious do we take “The Great Commission” (Mark 16:15-16)?
- II. Every person should hear the Gospel at least one time (Luke 24:46-47; Acts 1:8; John 6:45).

Discussion

- I. We must understand that mankind is lost without the Gospel (2 Cor. 4:3-4).
 - A. Jew and Gentile are all in need (Rom. 3:9, 23; cf. Psm. 19:7; Acts 3:19, 26; 17:30).
 - B. Only the Gospel is the power unto salvation (Rom. 1:16; 1 Cor. 1:21; Rom. 10:13-17).
- II. God loves all people, and so should we (John 3:16-17).
 - A. We show our love for souls by preaching and teaching the Gospel (Mark 16:15).
 - B. It does not matter who a person is, where the person is from, or what the person has done-ALL NEED OUR LOVE (Acts 10:34-35; 17:26).
- III. The evangelism of the world is our responsibility.
 - A. 2 Cor. 4:7
 - B. Men proclaimed the saving message of the Gospel (Acts 8:26-39; Acts 11:13-14; 9:5-6, 22:16).
 - C. The church has a great responsibility (1 Tim. 3:15; John 4:35; Luke 10:2).
 - D. If the early church could do it, then so can we (Col. 1:23; Rom. 10:16-19).
