Introduction

- I. It would have been wonderful to hear the Lord while He was on the Earth.
- II. Some had that privilege, and after hearing Him, recognized that He was special.

Discussion

- I. There is no doubt that Jesus amazed some of His listeners (John 7:32-46).
 - A. There were some that acknowledged Jesus as "the Prophet" (v. 40).
 - B. Others acknowledged that Jesus "is the Christ" (v. 41).
- II. What was so special about the speakings of Jesus?
 - A. Jesus claimed to be Deity (John 1:1-2; 17:5; Phil. 2:6).
 - B. Jesus spoke of the unity between He and the Father (John 10:30; 14:9).
 - C. Jesus claimed complete obedience (John 6:38; 8:29).
 - D. Jesus mentioned that He is the exclusive way to the Father (John 14:6; cf. 6:63)..
 - E. The words of Jesus were powerful against the devil (Matt. 4:1-11; John 12:31; 1 John 3:8).
 - F. Jesus described what Heaven is like (John 14:1-3; Matt. 5:34).
 - G. Jesus spoke of the soul's value (Mark 8:36; Matt. 10:28).
