Blessed is the Man

Introduction:

- 1. What kind of person would we consider to be blessed (of or enjoying happiness specially the bliss of heaven (Matthew 5).
 - a. Someone who is rich?
 - b. Someone who is powerful?
 - c. Someone who is popular?
- 2. The word that is translated blessed is defined as: "consider fortunate, call happy, or to be called happy.
- 3. Let us look at who God considers to be a blessed man.

Discussion:

- I. The Blessed Man (Psalm 1:1-3, 6a)
 - A. The blessed man is not...
 - 1. One that walks in the council of the ungodly.
 - 2. One that stands in the way of sinners.
 - 3. One that sits in the seat of the scornful (Matthew 7:1-5).
 - B. The blessed man is one that...
 - 1. Delights in the law of the Lord
 - a. David delighted in the law (Psalm 122:1)
 - b. We far too often take the law of the Lord lightly (John 14:15).
 - 2. He meditates on the Lord day and night.
 - a. We must dwell on His law.
 - b. We must study His law (2 Tim. 2:15)
 - 3. He is like a tree

- a. Planted by the rivers of water.
- b. Giveth forth fruit in his season (Matt. 13:23)
- c. His leaf shall not wither.
- d. Whatsoever he doth shall prosper (Matt. 6:33)
- II. The Cursed Man (Psalm 1:4-5, 6b)
 - A. Like the chaff
 - 1. They are unstable (James 1:8)
 - 2. They have no foundation (Matt. 7:26-27)
 - B. They shall not stand
 - 1. In the day of judgment (Matt. 7:21-23)
 - 2. Nor in the congregation of the righteous.

Conclusion:

- 1. The Lord knoweth the way of the righteous (Revelation 2:10; 2 Peter 3:9).
 - a. He cares about us
 - b. He takes notice of the righteousness
- 2. The way of the ungodly shall perish
 - a. This does not mean that they will have no success
 - b. They will ultimately fail
 - c. "Never molested though in the wrong" Farther Along
- 3. Are we...
 - a. Living a godly life and blessed.
 - b. Living cursed in our unrighteousness.
