 - B. Through prayer (Psm. 145:18; Heb. 4:16).
 - C. Through worship (1 Cor. 10:16; Heb. 13:15).
 - D. Through living godly lives (1 John 1:7).

 - A. Our hearts can be far from Him (Matt. 15:8-9).
 - B. We can draw back unto perdition (Heb. 10:39).
 - C. We can ignore and disobey His Word (Jer. 6:16; 18:12; James 4:17).
