## "God is Real and His Word is Truth" Rom. 1:18-21

Introduction

- I. The world seems more and more to go away from a belief in God and His Word.
- II. As Christians, we must have developed a faith that is rock solid, and also we must teach others the truth about God and His Word.
- III. If things do not change, they will continue to get worse (2 Tim. 3:13).

## Discussion

- I. Some reasons to believe that God is real.
  - A. The law of cause and effect (Heb. 3:4).
  - B. "Natural" revelation (Psm. 19:1-3; Acts 14:15-17; 17:24-29).
  - C. "Special" revelation (Gen. 1:1, 31; Heb. 11:3).
    - 1. Order in the world (Gen. 1:26-28).
    - 2. Morality (Heb. 5:12-14).
    - 3. From whence did I come (Gen. 2:7)?
    - 4. What is the meaning of life (Eccl. 12:13-14)?
    - 5. What is my future (Heb. 9:27; John 5:28-29)?
- II. Some reasons to accept God's Word is truth (John 17:17).
  - A. Do the Bible and true science agree (1 Tim. 6:19-21)?
    - 1. The Bible affirmed the "roundness" of the Earth when mankind largely believed that the world was flat (Isa. 40:22).
    - In 50 B.C., Hipparchus claimed that there were less than 3,000 stars, and in 150 A.D. Ptolemy claimed that there were not more than 3,000 (Gen. 15:5; 22:17; Jer. 33:22).
  - B. Do the Bible and true history agree (Psm. 78:1-4)?
    - 1. Herodotus claimed that Moses wrote false history when it came to Egyptians growing grapes and making wine (Gen. 40:9-14).
      - a. Critics believed Herodotus to be true.
      - b. Archaeologists discovered paintings of Egyptians crushing grapes and making wine.
    - 2. Skeptics claimed that Sergius Paulus should have never been called "proconsul", but rather "propraetor" (Acts 13:6-12).
      - a. "Propraetor" was usually the title used.
      - b. However, a coin was found that had inscribed "Paulus the Proconsul".
  - C. Does the Bible agree with Itself (Psm. 19:7-10)?
    - 1. 66 books written by approximately 40 different men from different walks of life, over hundreds of years, in different languages, and in different countries.
    - 2. Complete harmony, without contradictions because of the Bible's source (2 Pet. 1:21).

## Conclusion

- I. Evidence supports that God is real and that His Word is truth.
- II. If I believe such, then I must make sure to obey God and His Word because I will meet both in Judgment (John 12:48).
