Introduction

- I. It is alarming to see how much indifference exists in the world today.
- II. Instead of being diligent, many behave as if they do not care (Rev. 3:15-16).
- III. When it comes to Christianity, why are so many indifferent?

Discussion

- I. Humanism
 - A. Focuses on human interests and desires, and emphasizes human reason instead of faith in God.
 - B. Humanism is a form of idolatry, placing man as supreme instead of God (Rom. 1:23-32; cf. Luke 9:23).
- II. Materialism/Worldliness
 - A. Physical wealth and gratification is emphasized instead of faith in God.
 - B. This way of life is carnal and not spiritual (Rom. 8:6-8).
 - C. Cannot live like this and love God (Matt. 6:24).
 - D. Solomon lived a very materialistic life, and he concluded it to be vanity (Eccl. 2:4-11).
- III. Hypocrisy
 - A. Too many claiming to be “Christians” do not live what they “preach” (Rom. 12:1-2; 1 Pet. 2:11-12).
 - B. Religious division (John 17:20-21; 1 Cor. 1:10).
